### Local Enforcement System (LES)

The LES caters for all contraventions and offences pertaining to the Code Of Police Laws, Motor Vehicle Insurance Ordinance, Motor Vehicle Regulations, Traffic Regulations, Traffic Regulation Ordinance, Traffic Signs and Carriage Way Markings Regulations, Education Act, Planning Authority, Regulations on Skips and Litter Act. The general public will have the possibility to settle payment for contraventions via the internet.

### Fleet Management System (FMS)

The FMS monitors mobile asset movements, both on land and at sea. Two network infrastructures are employed: GPS and the proprietary Datatrak RF Network for terrestrial tracking applications and tracking of vessels within the territorial waters, and Inmarsat-C/GPS for global tracking. The FMS is used by diverse entities mainly to control fleet use, time and attendance, fuel consumption and for prompt interventions in distress circumstances.

## Land Registry Certification System (LRCS)

The LRCS was developed in 1995 to provide the Land Registry Department with an automated application to handle the registration of properties throughout the Maltese Islands.

### Water Information System (WIS)

The WIS is a tool for analysis of water services data. It utilises a geocoded physical addresses dataset collected and maintained by Datatrak IT Services, which is linked to the Water Services Corporation (WSC) clients' addresses dataset, thereby adding a geographical component to the WSC dataset. WIS is capable of monitoring and reporting on various aspects of water management at national level.
